# Eyebrow PMU Aftercare

After your appointment, it is very important to follow your Aftercare Instructions. Aftercare accounts for 70% of your final results!

## First Day/Day of Your Appointment

When you arrive home after having your Eyebrow PMU service, gently peel off the bandages toward your ear, like a banana. You will notice that some lymph and blood may come to the skin's surface. If this is not cleaned well, it will create crusting. To prevent crusting, you must GENTLY clean the area using your Angel Care wipes by gently wiping the brows to soften any lymph. First pat to soak in the direction of hair growth then wipe both ways gently. Do this every two hour the same day of your appointment.

#### Days 2-4

After the first day, you are NOT to wipe your brows for the next 3 days. Instead, fold the Angel Care Wipes and PAT the treated area gently every 2-3 hours following the direction of hair growth. After each time you PAT your Powder Brows, apply Angel Care Gel to promote faster healing. You can cut your wipes in half too! Remember, you only need a rice grain sized amount SPLIT between your two brows each time you apply it.

### Days 4+

After the third day following your treatment, use only the Angel Care Gel as needed and avoid water, sweating, and any other facial products on the treated area until a FULL 7 days after your appointment.

#### General Aftercare Guides

- Avoid heavy sweating and exercising for 7 days. KEEP THEM DRY!
- DO NOT PICK AT ANY FLAKING.
- Avoid any treatments involving touching the brows such as facials, lash extensions, etc. for 10 days.
- Avoid the sauna, steam room, and swimming for 10 days
- Do not use any makeup on the treated area for 10 days
- No other ointments other than the Angel Care Gel should be used for 10 days.
- Neosporin or Bacitracin type products should be avoided in the treated area because they may negatively affect the color retention.
- Sunbathing and tanning should be avoided for 10 days
